ANL Warragul 554 denied into Tauranga, New Zealand

We regret to advise ANL Warragul 554 has been denied entry in Tauranga by New Zealand Quarantine (MPI) due to an Australian Bogong Moth infestation.

The vessel has been directed by the New Zealand Authorities to return to Sydney where under the direction of the Australian Authorities (DAWR) a moth eradication programme will be undertaken.

As a consequence, the vessel will now be delayed, with her return ETA to Tauranga to be confirmed as soon as possible.

Continuing Congestion in Singapore

Please note that there continues to be issues in tranship ports due to congestion and lack of available sailings, equipment and space. Singapore is suffering the worst of the delays at

about 4-6 weeks, so for vessels going to Perth this may be a real issue where there is no options but to tranship.

We are doing everything we can to minimise the impact on our clients but where there is no option but to tranship our hands are tied. Sometimes it is taking 4-6 weeks just to get space on vessels so this is an extremely stressful time for everyone and I ask our clients to try and maintain patience and know we are trying to do everything we can.
