Ex Korea, China, Hong Kong, Taiwan & Southeast Asia to Australia - **USD300/TEU & USD600/FEU effective 1st August**

Ex China, Hong Kong, Korea, Taiwan & Southeast Asia to **New Zealand** - **USD200/20' & USD400/40' effective 1st August**

Ex Northeast Asia to Australia - **USD300/20' & USD600/40' effective 1st August**

Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB) Risk Season

The next BMSB season begins on 1st September - 30th April 2019, targeted risk countries include USA, Italy, Germany, France, Russia, Greece, Hungary, Romania, Georgia and Japan.

The Dept of Agriculture (DAWR) will require all treatment providers performing BMSB treatments in Italy and the USA to be registered with the department on an approved list of offshore treatment providers.

It is important that clients advise their suppliers who organise treatments offshore to make sure that the treatment providers are registered.

DAWR requires shipments of targeted high risk goods to be fumigated OFFSHORE.

Target high risk goods requiring mandatory offshore treatment and arriving untreated, will be directed for export or destruction, unless exceptional circumstances are granted.

The targeted high risk commodities and mandatory offshore fumigation

- Break bulk, including vehicles, machinery and equipment.
- Bricks, tiles, ceramics, steel, stone, cement.
- Goods likely to be stored in a manner that provides access for BMSB to over winter

Targeted risk goods that will be directed for increased onshore fumigation

- Chemicals, chemical products, salt, minerals, fertilisers
 - Wood pulp, printed matter, straw, paper, cardboard
 - Plastics, wadding, tyres

Exempted goods

- Fresh Produce (including nursery stock and plants)
- Live animals
- Food for human consumption (including beverages)
- Seeds for sowing
- Registered Pharmaceuticals

Treatments

- Sulfuryl fluoride fumigation
- Methyl bromide fumigation
- Heat treatment

Auckland Regional Fuel Tax

As you may be aware, an Auckland Regional Fuel Tax will be added to the price of fuel in the coming weeks.

At this stage we believe it will be 12.5c per litre. This cost will be a direct cost to Stockwells and therefore we will unfortunately have to pass this onto our customers.

Once this fuel tax starts you will see a line at the bottom of your invoice under FAF called, Regional Fuel Tax (RFT). We will be using the table below to calculate the charge.

Using a table outside of your standard rates will allow us to adjust the RFT or remove completely depending on when changes are made to the tax rate.

TABLE

0 to 5c per litre	1%
5.1c to 10c	2%
10.1c to 15c	3%
15.1c to 20c	4%

Mexican Inland Situation

According to Mexican Law (NOM-12), as of June 27, 2018 all trucks moving cargoes on Tandem basis must have a sticker allowing them to transit within the Mexican Territory in that modality.

This has originated as some trucking lines have reported their trucks only for single movements with the additional cost that this represents. Currently the availability of trucks is limited; nevertheless, they are being

assigned according to the "first come first served" principle.

The law is applicable all over the Country and it is affecting all shipping companies as well as customers moving their cargoes on their own. Since this is a market situation, the number of re-schedule cargoes can increase due to the limited number of trucks that will be available in the next days.

Kindly note that Stockwells will not be responsible for any extra cost caused by potential delays for reasons such as storages, schedule changes, handlings, electricity, demurrages, or any other costs out of our control due to this Market situation.
